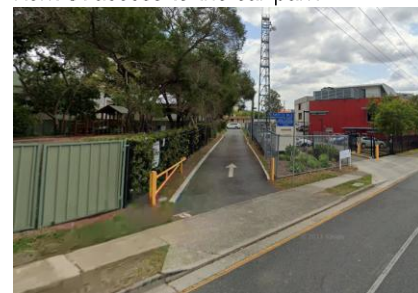

Kent St access to the car park



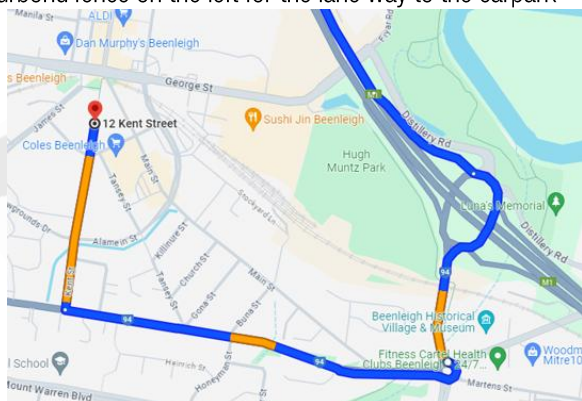
Driving Directions to the Venue

Travel 400m at the roundabout, take the 4th exit onto Main St. / state route 94,

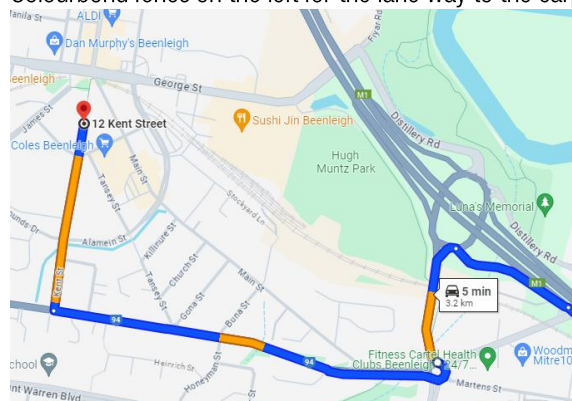
Travel 1.3kms turn right onto Kent St. Look for the green Colourbond fence on the left for the lane way to the carpark
