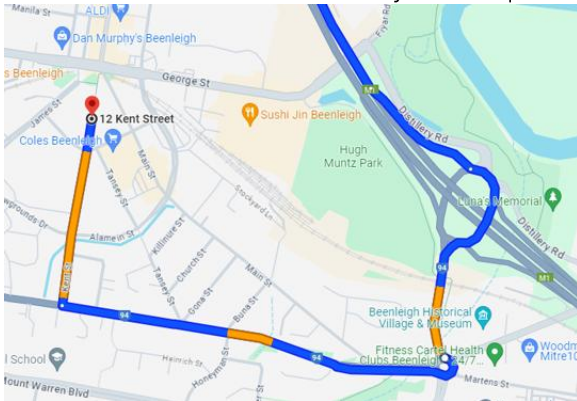
## Driving Directions to the Venue

Directions - coming south from Brisbane or north from the Gold Coast take Exit 35 Beenleigh South on the m1.

From the Brisbane, at the roundabout, take the 4<sup>th</sup> exit onto state route 94.

Travel 400m at the roundabout, take the 4th exit onto Main St. / state route 94,

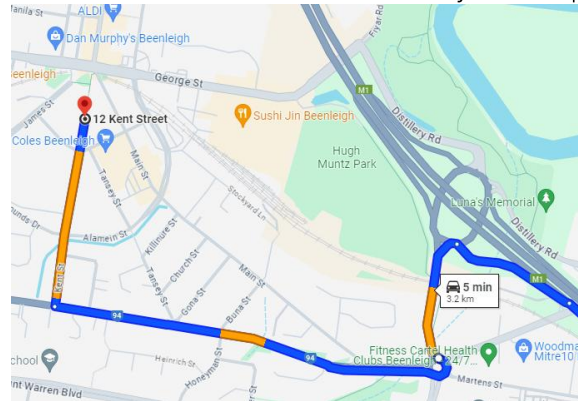
Travel 1.3kms turn right onto Kent St. Look for the green Colourbond fence on the left for the lane way to the carpark
